



METALS LANDFILL LEGAL DESCRIPTION

That portion of Adak Naval Air Station, Adak Island, Alaska, described as follows:

Commencing at U.S. Navy control point J-12 (which is a 37MM shell case stamped J-12 EL 1945 set in the top of a 8-inch square concrete monument) which is South 8°48'39" East 1,100.74 feet (record = 1,100.39 feet) from U.S. Navy control point J-13 (which is a 37MM shell case stamped J-13 EL 1945 set in the top of a 8-inch square concrete monument);
